Farmer Street – New Water Main & Sanitary Sewer and Street Reconstruction

General Description of the Work on Farmer Street:

This project involves the complete reconstruction of Farmer Street from Blunk to Theodore. Along with the new roadway, new sanitary sewer and water main will be installed at various locations throughout the corridor. New storm sewer will be installed at the intersections.

Improvement Project Details:

Anticipated Start Date: July 13, 2020 (signs may appear earlier)
Anticipated Duration: Work will continue through the summer and is expected to be complete in late September 2020

Water Main and Sanitary Sewer Improvements:

- New 8-inch water main, new valves and hydrants
- New water services up to right-of-way line
- New sanitary sewer between Adams and Theodore

At various times, the public water service will be shut-off in order to make connections to the system. Notice will be given to residents in advance of water service interruption. Notices will be delivered to your front door. All new water main will undergo bacteriological and pressure testing prior to being placed in service.

Road Reconstruction:

- Complete road reconstruction (new curb and gutter, new aggregate base and new asphalt)
- New concrete drive approaches up to right-of-way line
- Miscellaneous sidewalk repairs will also be made.

Safety is Important - Please use caution when walking, jogging, biking or driving in the construction area.

The following is provided as a tentative contractor schedule. Contractor schedules are often subject to change due to weather, field conditions, and material availability.

Anticipated Sequence of Construction

| 7. Restoration | Mid to late September 2020 |

Garbage Collection will remain on its normal collection day. If your garbage does not get picked up for some reason, please call the City Department of Municipal Services and they will assist in getting it collected.

Access to residences will be maintained throughout construction. Vehicular access to drive approaches will be interrupted for approximately 7 to 10 days when the new curb and gutter is poured. Notice will be given in advance of interruption so that people can get their cars out of the driveway.

Junction Street – Concrete Joint and Pavement Repairs

General Description of the Work on Junction Street:

This project involves repairing the existing concrete pavement joints on Junction from Blunk to Karmada. This is a continuation of the joint repair work completed in 2018 and 2019.

Improvement Project Details:

Anticipated Start Date: Likely in the early Fall (September) after Farmer Street
Anticipated Duration: Work will be performed in two phases, the north half and the south half

Traffic Control:

- During the joint repairs, Junction will set up for one way traffic
- Miscellaneous sidewalk repairs may be made at intersections

Safety is Important - Please use caution when walking, jogging, biking or driving in the construction area.

Garbage Collection will remain on its normal collection day. If your garbage does not get picked up for some reason, please call the City Department of Municipal Services and they will assist in getting it collected.

Access to residences will be maintained throughout construction as much as possible. We will coordinate with individual residences as work if work impacts a drive approach to your property. Notice will be given in advance of interruption so that people can get their cars out of the driveway.

Ann Street – New Fire Hydrant

General Description of the Work on Ann Street:

This project involves the installation of a new fire hydrant on Ann Street midway between Farmer and Junction.

Improvement Project Details:

Anticipated Start Date: Likely completed between July 20th and August 20th
Anticipated Duration: One day for the hydrant installation, plus a couple days for curb and asphalt repairs.

Traffic Control:

- During the hydrant installation, Ann will be closed in the area of the new hydrant.
- The street will be opened back up at the end of the day.

Safety is Important - Please use caution when walking, jogging, biking or driving in the construction area.

Garbage Collection will remain on its normal collection day. If your garbage does not get picked up for some reason, please call the City Department of Municipal Services and they will assist in getting it collected.

Access to residences will be maintained throughout construction as much as possible.

Evergreen Street Resurfacing

General Description of the Work on Evergreen Street:

This project involves the resurfacing of Evergreen between Blanche and Farmer. The resurfacing will include cold milling of 1.5 inches of asphalt plus base repairs before the new layer of asphalt is placed. One new storm catch basin is being added on the west side of Evergreen to improve drainage in this area.

Improvement Project Details:

Anticipated Start Date: Likely completed between July 13th and August 20th
Anticipated Duration: One day for the installation of the new underground storm sewer and catch basin. Paving work will likely be coordinated with the Main Street resurfacing project.

Traffic Control:

- During this project, Evergreen will be open to thru traffic.
- Please note that the milled surface may remain for a period of time prior to resurfacing. As we better understand the details related to the timing of this project, notices will be provided to the residences along this block.

Safety is Important - Please use caution when walking, jogging, biking or driving in the construction area.

Garbage Collection will remain on its normal collection day. If your garbage does not get picked up for some reason, please call the City Department of Municipal Services and they will assist in getting it collected.

Access to residences will be maintained throughout construction as much as possible.

Main Street Resurfacing

General Description of the Work on Main Street:

This project involves the resurfacing of Main Street between Wing and Church through the downtown business district. The resurfacing will include cold milling of 1.5 inches of asphalt plus base repairs before the new layer of asphalt is placed. One storm catch basin repair will be made at Wing and Main Street. Restriping of Main Street will follow the resurfacing.

Improvement Project Details:

Anticipated Start Date: Week of July 13th

Anticipated Duration: Anticipated to be complete by end of July 2020

Traffic Control and Coordination with Businesses:

- During this project, Main Street will be open but there may be lane reductions in both directions.
- Please note that the milled surface will be rough prior to resurfacing.
- The Contractor, City and WT will be coordinating the work to minimize impact to the outdoor seating areas.
