- Sidewalk closures can only occur at residential addresses with valid permits for demolition, new construction, or sizeable addition(s).
- Clear indication (caution tape, snow fence, barricade, etc.) must be in place to alert pedestrians to sidewalk closure.
- Cones with reflective tape must be provided by the contractor or homeowner and remain by the dumpster throughout its duration on the street.
- Permits for sidewalk closure and dumpster in right-of-way expires after 90 days.
